

Croydon/Sandilands Tram Disaster Inquests commence

On Monday 17th May, the substantive hearing into the inquests of 7 passengers who died in the Sandilands Tram derailment on 9th November 2016, started at Croydon Town Hall before the Senior Coroner for South London. Miles Bennett, instructed by Gary Rubin at Blackfords LLP, is representing the tram driver Mr Dorris. The inquest is due to last for some 13 weeks.
